Want to make some friends and make a difference? The Friends of the Glencoe Public Library is a group that raises funds for the Glencoe Public Library, for programming and special library purchases. We welcome new volunteers! Here are some of the things The Friends do:

CONCERTS: We hold classical music concerts at the library, free to the community, in the Spring and in the Fall. We need volunteers to bake, host, set-up, and clean-up.

USED BOOK SALES: We have used book sales three times a year to raise funds for the library. We need people to help on sale weekends, on Saturdays from 9 a.m. –5 p.m.; Sundays from noon - 5 p.m.; and on Mondays from 9 a.m. – noon. The "shifts" are one hour in length, and you can work as many shifts as you have time available.

BOOK ROOM: Every Tuesday afternoon from about 1 - 3 p.m., and every Friday morning from about 10 a.m. - noon, we need volunteers to help in the book room. The times are very flexible. Some people stay for a couple of hours, some stay for 30 minutes. Come when you can, stay as long as you can--whatever works best with your schedule. You do not need to sign up in advance-- just drop in when you can. A few people are "trained" pricers, the rest of us shelve the books. It's a good way to meet the other volunteers, and it's fun!
